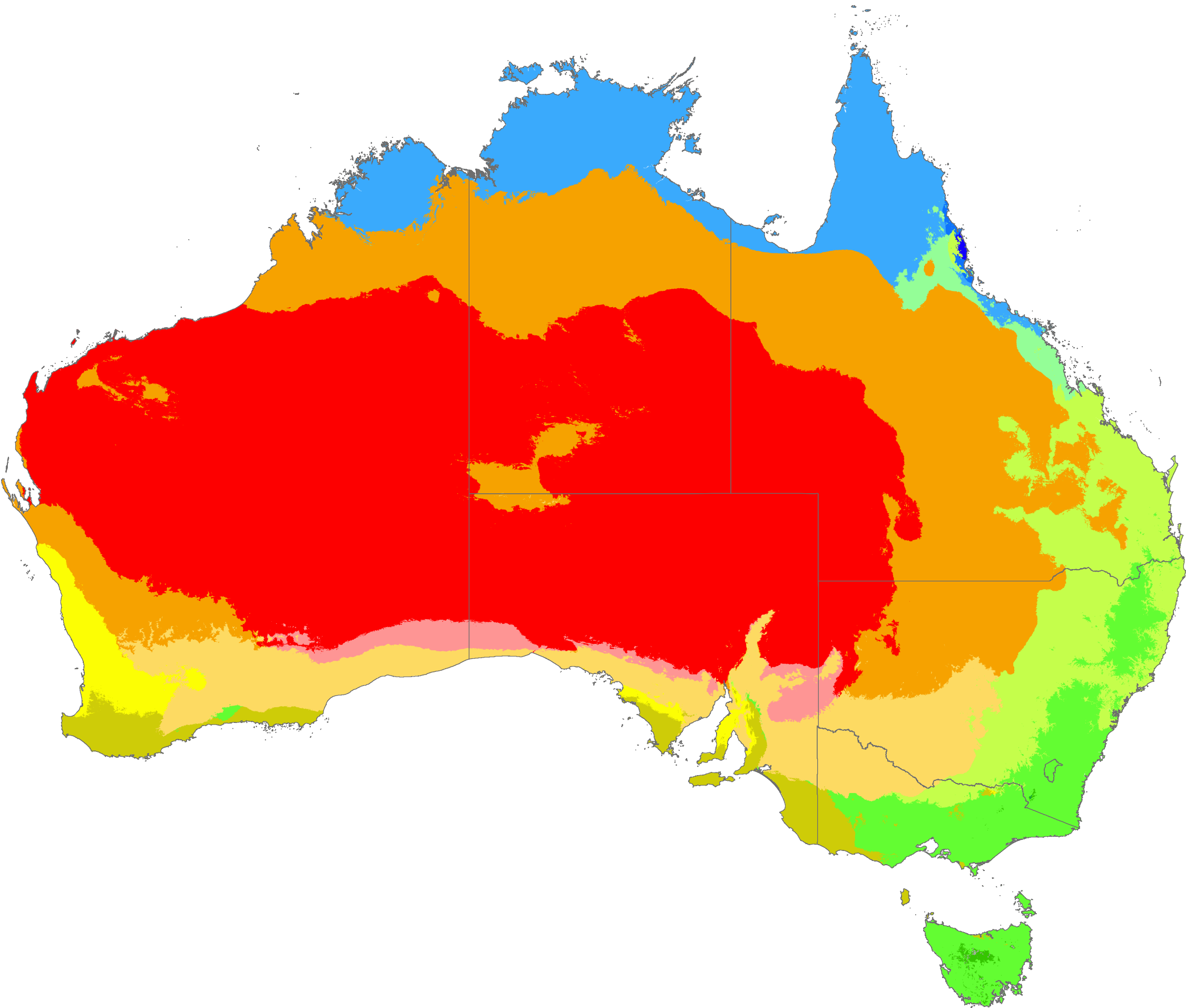


Köppen climate types of Australia

| Cfb (Oceanic) | BSk (Cold semi-arid) | Am (Monsoon) |
| Cfa (Humid subtropical) | BSh (Hot semi-arid) | Af (Rainforest) |
